

2024 WMX SUPPLEMENTAL RULES

The following Rules supplement the current AMA Racing Rulebook, which governs amateur racing. Current AMA members in good standing may compete. For the 2024 AMA Racing Rulebook, go [HERE](#).

A. WMX RACE SCHEDULE

B. RIDER ELIGIBILITY

1. WMX is a female class.
2. Former or current AMA professional licensed riders are eligible for the class.

C. MACHINE ELIGIBILITY

1. **Machine size:** 122-250cc machines only. Must be 14 years old to race 250cc.
2. No superminis.
3. Combustion engines only.

D. CHAMPIONSHIP POINTS

1. **Race Format:** Two-moto format at 15 minutes plus one lap per moto, with the exception of RCSX. RCSX shall be a main moto format paying double points, counted as two motos.
2. Championship points will be awarded per moto based on the following point scale:

3. Class championship will be determined by the rider's best 12 moto finishes.

D. PURSE

1. WMX is a purse-paying class. The purse will consist of the greater of 100% of the class entry fees or \$1500, at a minimum as follows:

3rd	\$125
4th	\$75
5th	\$50

2. Riders who accept a monetary purse award will lose their AMA "C" class ranking.
