



## Loretta Lynn Vet Regional (South Central) Additional Information

### **Admission Process:**

Please bring your own pen for signing any paperwork that is required. We will not have pens available for use.

- Upon entry, guests will be greeted by staff wearing PPE and will have digital ticket scanned to
  receive wristband for entry. Release signatures will be required at gate before entry. (online
  purchasing link: <u>https://freestonemx.ticketspice.com/loretta-lynns-south-central-vet-regional</u>)
- ALL gate and camping fees will be done online <u>PRIOR</u> to your arrival at the track. There will be no cash pay option for gate or camping fees. If you arrive without purchasing, you will be asked to download the Ticketspice app to purchase your tickets online.
- We ask you contain your own trash and dispose of it in our dumpster at the front gate as needed or on your way home. Thanks in advance for pitching in.
- Please park no less than 10 feet apart from your neighbor on all sides.
- Please remain in your chosen pit area unless going to/from registration, concessions, or the racetrack. Do not roam or visit your neighbors use your phone for that.

#### **Registration Process:**

• Registration is located at the Announcer Tower. Please bring your own pen for use at registration. We will not have pens laying out

- Registration for the Loretta's qualifying classes will be done via Kiosk at the tower.
  - You must have first registered for your classes on the MX Sports website before coming to the track.
  - Once you have registered with MX Sports when you arrive at Freestone you will visit eScore to get a transponder and then come to the kiosk to register.
- Registration for support classes (non-qualifying classes) will be ONLINE ONLY. You must go to the Freestonemx.com website and enter for the supporting classes. <u>We will NOT be doing any paper</u> registration at the tower. (Online registration open Mon. June 8th thru Tues. June 16th 11pm CST.)
- AMA cards must be purchased/renewed on the AMA website prior to arrival to the track. If you come to registration without an AMA or with an expired AMA card you will be asked to go to the AMA website to purchase/renew your membership. <u>This will not be done at the track to comply</u> with contactless registration processes.
- All riders are required to register. No one is permitted on track without registering.

• We ask that only the rider, or in the event of an amateur rider, their parent, attend registration. No extra people will be allowed to congregate near or around the tower.

• Minor release for riders under 18 will need to be printed at home, completed, and brought with you to the track. (Minor release is found on Freestone website under Loretta Lynn information.)

• Registration can be paid by credit card or exact cash. Chip readers will be positioned so that riders can insert their credit card directly without handing it to the clerk. No signature required. Change will not be given for cash sales. Please come prepared with EXACT change to registration.

• Riders will be given a practice sticker to confirm to staging staff they are eligible for track access.

## **Motocross Track:**

We will have 9 qualifying classes for Loretta's:

- Open Pro Sport
- 250 Pro Sport
- College (18-24) (Sportsman)
- Junior (25+)
- Vet (30+) (Sportsman)
- Senior (40+)
- Senior (45+) (Sportsman)
- Masters (50+)
- > Women

We will have 5 support classes that are not associated with Loretta's qualifying:

- ➢ 50cc 4-8 open
- ➢ 65cc 7-11 open
- Mini Sr. 12-15
- Schoolboy 12-17
- Big Bike Open
- Depending upon the size of the group, it may be necessary to have more than one session per group.
- Our motocross track will be fully staffed with caution flaggers. Please be familiar with the caution flag rules. There is no jumping or passing on Yellow or Red Cross flags.
- Only 1 rider / 1 mechanic to staging. Due to social distancing concerns, mechanics are encouraged to wear facemasks while in staging.
- Riders need to distance themselves from other riders and keep their helmets on at staging.
- Riders must ride alone and may not transport anyone on their bikes.

### Health Considerations:

• Social distancing is key. That means standing at least 6 feet apart from another person.

• When you are unable to social distance or stand 6 feet apart, we recommend you wear a facemask to protect you from others and others from you. Just use common sense. Besides, it is Cool to be Covered!

• We will have hand sanitizer available at all workstations, the front gate, staging, near the restrooms, escore, and registration.

• An Isolation Station will be located at the front gate for persons feeling ill. If you think you have a fever or start to feel ill, please do not go to the EMS Station. We have a special Isolation Station at the front gate. Please go there so you do not infect the EMS Station.

•The CDC recommends persons who are sick with fever or cough, elderly or at high risk, to stay at home. We do too. Please do not attend our event if this is you.

• Please take your temperature before you leave home. If you have a temperature of at least 100.4, you have a fever and should stay home.

• If you know you have had contact with someone diagnosed with having COVID-19 in the last 14 days, or you yourself have had COVID-19 in the last 30 days, please stay home.
