LL Regional Supplemental Rules

Rider Age:

- For Youth classes the age of the rider on **January 1, 2021** will determine their age for the remainder of the year.
- For all other classes, the age of the rider is determined as of the date of the event.

- 2S = 2 Stroke; 4S = 4 Stroke
- WB = Wheelbase; FW = Front Wheel Maximum; RW = Rear Wheel Maximum; Inch Measurement = Max Size unless stated otherwise;
- SS (Single Speed), MS (Multi-Speed), AC (Air Cooled)

*** Riders may attempt to qualify in more than one class, but may only enter one class at the National.

Regional Plus (R+) Classes: In addition to the National Classes, riders may compete in Regional Plus Classes for AMA Regional Championships at the regionals. Registration is open, and Regional Plus Classes do not require advancement from Area Qualifiers. Regional Plus Classes will NOT advance to the National Championship. Rider and machine eligibility requirements set forth herein apply to Regional Plus Classes.
